Old Business

Gravel Pit

Auditor Solberg told the BOCC that a concerned citizen sent a letter over to the County on to sell the gravel pit. The BOCC will look into how to sell the gravel pit.

American Rescue Plan Funds

Larrabee Township ran an ad for septic tank installation at the Grace City School. Central Valley Health is looking into the project.

New Business

Nate Monson, Road Superintendent, sent out a sheet for his update. Monson stated mowing is done and docks are removed from Juanita Lake. Monson had two quotes for a Reclaimer.

-Gilbertson Trucking "Diamond Disc" for \$9,685

-Platte SD "The Retriever" for \$11,200

Commissioner Scanson made a motion to purchase the reclaimer from Gilbertson Trucking for \$9,685, seconded by Commissioner Copenhaver. All voted aye and the motion passed.

Donny Theis, Carrington Township Supervisor, put in a request for a culvert replacement. This culvert was not on Kelly Creek or a Share Road and was stated that is does not meet the county's bridge definition. The BOCC did not approve the culvert request. Theis then put in a request for gravel on 2nd St NE, which is a share road, for \$4,256.25, commissioner Scanson made a motion to pay their share of the gravel for \$4,256.25, seconded by Commissioner Beumer. All voted aye and the motion passed.

Auditor Solberg presented the Arrowwood Propane Contract to the BOCC. Commissioner Beumer made a motion to accept the contract, seconded by Commissioner Scanson. All voted aye and the motion passed.

Township meeting dates were discussed. The idea is to have Township meetings on November 29-30.

Commissioner Utke presented a share road proposal for the 2022 year. Utke's proposal worked off Scanson's proposal from 2021. Utke's proposal would add township miles into the equation. The BOCC had questions that they would like answered prior to making a final decision.

With no further business, Commissioner Hagel adjourned the meeting at 5:33pm.
