

PROCEEDINGS OF THE FOSTER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

March 4th, 2022

At 8:30am, Vice Chairman Scanson called the Foster County Commission Special meeting to order. Roll call included Commissioner Alan Scanson, Commissioner Becky Hagel, Commissioner David Utke (phone), and Commissioner Scott Beumer (phone). Also present was Auditor Brad Solberg.
